ORDINANCE NO. 1707

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEAVER FALLS,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA IMPLEMENTING
PROVISIONS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR POLITICAL
SIGNS

SECTION 1

Council for the City of Beaver Falls has determined that it is appropriate for the health, safety and welfare of the citizen of Beaver Falls to implement provisions and restrictions for political signs

SECTION 2

The following provisions and restrictions shall apply to political signs:

- A. Political signs shall not be placed more than thirty (30) days before an election.
- B. Political sign shall not be placed on public property or attached to trees. Public property includes:
 - (1) the grass areas between the curb and sidewalk
 - (2) Telephone/Electric poles
 - (3) entrance areas into town
 - (4) walls along Seventh Avenue
 - (5) highway/street rights of way

The City's street department will remove signs found in these areas.

- C. Political signs shall only be placed on private property.
- D. Political sign shall not exceed five (5) square feet in area (i.e. 24" x 30" or 18" x 40" or 20" x 36")

SECTION 3

All signs shall be removed three (3) days after the election

SECTION 4

There is no fee or permit required for a political sign

SECTION 5

Any provisions or parts of other ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6


The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any provision of this ordinance is found unconstitutional or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of the ordinance shall be unaffected.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
